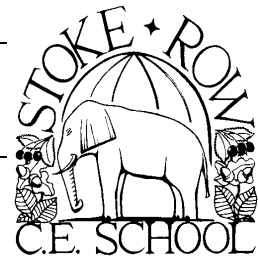

* **Children Stalls** - we still have space for your child to run his/her own stall if they want, just let us know what and how many tables you need.

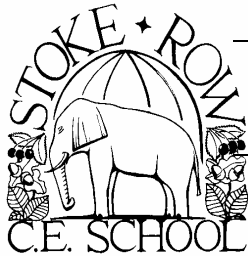

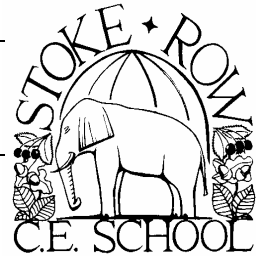
