## FOSRS MONEY

### Discussed

FOSRS have committed to £1000 this year for minibus maintenance costs and around £250 per class for their outings. FOSRS have also agreed (at the last meeting) to raise £10000 over the next 18 months or so towards a new minibus.

Actions

Ask Graham Whittaker's advice as he organised fund raising for the last minibus - **Rachel**  
Letter out to explain to parents why we are raising money towards a new minibus and ask for any ideas they might have for raising this money (sponsors?) - **RachL/Rachel**  
Investigate auction of promises idea - **Rachel**  
Need to think about how we divide FOSRS money raised between funds for minibus and other funds (e.g. 80% of summer fete money goes towards the new minibus and 20% towards other FOSRS projects like day trips) - **Rachel**

Look into how we could sort out the area in school with the bird table on (need to speak to Kirsty) - **Ann**  
Stoke Row School reusable bags (for sale at fete, each child draws a picture of themselves and they are all printed on the bag along with School logo), agreed would organise 150 to sell at around £3 each - **Xanthe**
