- We co-create classroom rules at a class level which are reviewed together to understand the rationale and consequences.
- School rules are consistently modelled and highlighted in assemblies and in our PSCHÉ learning
- There are rewards for exhibiting kind and caring behaviour which link to our school values and vision which is central to all we do. Children may be placed

on the Golden Elephant in class, receive house points or star of the week in recognition of their teamwork and community focused behaviour.

- We have high expectations of pupil behaviour and conduct which is reflected in our behaviour policy. We consistently model school rules and use assemblies to discuss why laws exist and how they protect everyone.
